- white → Language Arts
- green → Science
- orange – study skills
- yellow → Homework and Planning

- _____ 1 black hard-back 1 ½" 3-ring binder with plastic view on the front, back, and spine (for Spanish)

If these specific binder colors are not available, please slide a piece of construction paper in the plastic pocket in the binder's front, back, and spine. The color coding will help the students organize their academic materials.
