ALL STUDENTS MUST HAVE:

- AN ASSIGNMENT BOOK
- PENS, PENCILS and LOOSE-LEAF PAPER

CLASSICAL LANGUAGE

Latin: Large spiral notebook with pockets. Index cards for vocabulary are optional. A Latin dictionary should be purchased for all levels of Latin.

COMPUTER SCIENCE

Programming I and Advanced Programming: Three-ring binder with dividers.

All other semester computer classes: One pocket folder.

ENGLISH

Three ring binder with dividers, highlighters and index cards.

FOREIGN LANGUAGE

French: Large spiral notebook with pockets. Optional index cards.

Spanish: Three-ring binder with dividers, black and red pens, highlighters and 3x5 index cards.

MATHEMATICS

A Texas Instruments TI-83, TI-83 Plus, TI-83 Silver Edition, or TI-84 graphing calculator is required for all mathematics courses in the Upper School.

Teachers will announce the other requirements for their classes on the first day of school.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Ninth Grade P.E.: P.E. uniforms will be distributed by the Athletic Department and billed to your account by the business office. You will need to provide a towel, toiletries, white sport socks, indoor and outdoor athletic shoes and a lock for your gym locker (combination lock only).

P.E. 2: T-Shirt, shorts and athletic shoes. Lock for gym locker - optional (combination lock only)

Athletic Training: Three-ring binder with dividers and pocket dividers.

Sports Marketing: Three-ring binder with dividers and pocket dividers.

SCIENCE

All Science classes: Three-ring binder (2 inches thick) with dividers.

Chemistry: Calculator (see math requirement) & Marble composition book with graph paper or similar bound notebook with graph paper.

Physics: Calculator (see math requirement)

SOCIAL SCIENCE

Three-ring binder with dividers.

FINE ARTS SUPPLIES

2D Art and 2D Design:

Spiral (or hardbound) sketchbook at least 8.5x11, unlined pages
Regular pencil, mechanical pencil, eraser, pencil case, extra fine point black Sharpie

Art II:

All of the list above plus a set of drawing pencils (a set can wither be prepackaged or individually purchased in a range of softness such as 2H H HB 2B 4B and 6B) and a white eraser

AP 2D & AP Drawing

All supplies listed in 2d Art & 2D Design and Art II. Then expect to buy at least one set of a professional quality art media. As AP students work quite independently of each other it is not possible right now to say what that will be. It could be pastel, watercolor or colored pencils (prismacolors) or design markers (also prismacolors). I suggest you start looking at supplies and thinking about that this summer.

Photography:

film-type SLR camera with manual settings (ex: Pentax K -1000)
6 rolls TMAX 100 film, 36 exposures
6 rolls TMAX 400 film, 36 exposures
100 sheets Ilford RC Multigrade IV enlarging paper
one 2-inch binder (must be at least 2 inches)
a notebook or paper for taking notes

3D Art:

Cover-up clothes
3-ring Binder and paper.
