ADMISSION CHECKLIST

The admission process is broken into two cycles – first round and second round decisions. Applications for first round must be submitted by Friday, January 30, 2009 with admission decisions being rendered on Friday, March 6, 2009. Second round decisions occur on a rolling basis after the New Student Enrollment Contract Deadline of Friday, April 3, 2009. Many grades will fill following the first round; therefore, it is advisable to apply as soon as possible. The requirements listed below may be completed in any order; however, no applicant will be considered for admission until all required items have been submitted to Highland.

APPLICATION

Please submit an application and enclose a non-refundable application fee of \$50.

PARENT STATEMENT FOR PK 3/4

The Parent Statement should be submitted with the application.

APPLICANT STATEMENT FOR GRADES 6-12

The Applicant Statement should be completed in the applicant's own handwriting.

TEACHER RECOMMENDATION(S)

Applicants for PK 4/5-Grade 5 must submit one recommendation: Homeroom teacher.
Applicants for Grades 6-12 must submit two recommendations: Math and English teachers.

All recommendations must be sent directly from the applicant's school to Highland.

SCHOOL RECORDS OR TRANSCRIPTS

Please submit the Request for School Records form directly to your child's school. All records or transcripts must be sent directly from the applicant's school to Highland.

APPLICANT OBSERVATION OR VISIT

Applicants for PK 4/5 and K are required to attend a group observation on Saturday, February 7, 2009. Snow date: February 14, 2009.

Applicants for Grades 1-12 are required to complete a half-day visit. Visits are scheduled daily by appointment and applicants do not need to submit an application prior to the half-day visit.

PARENT INTERVIEW

Interviews are scheduled daily by appointment and most are conducted the same day as the applicant's visit.

TESTING

Applicants for PK 4/5 and K will be administered the Gesell screening at Highland on Monday, February 2, 2009 through Friday, February 6, 2009. No weekend testing is available.

Applicants for Grades 1-5 will be administered STAR testing during their half-day visit.

Applicants for Grades 6-12 are required to submit Secondary School Admission Test (SSAT) scores. Highland's school code is #3874. The SSAT will be administered at Highland on Saturday, January 17, 2009 at 9:00 a.m. to applicants only. Snow date: Saturday, January 24, 2009.

Applicants for Grades 11-12 may submit PSAT or SAT scores instead of SSAT scores.

PAYMENT PLANS

Single Payment:	Payment in full is due by July 1 and entitles K-Grade 12 families to a 1% discount.
Tri-Payment:	Three payments of 40% by July 1, 40% by September 1 and 20% by January 1.
Monthly Payment:	Ten equal payments due on the first of each month from July through April. This plan is sponsored through FACTS and requires direct withdrawal from a checking account or credit card.

FOUNDER'S SCHOLARSHIP

The mission of the Founder's Scholarship Program is to attract and retain students of exceptional intelligence who possess the highest qualities of leadership, character and citizenship. We seek to identify students with great promise early in their high school careers so that we may nurture their talents and allow the school to benefit from their enrollment. We are firm in the belief that extraordinary individuals enrich the entire community; thus, we award partial merit-based grants to enable talented youth to attend Highland. FINANCIAL AID

Highland provides need-based financial aid to students in Kindergarten through Grade 12. In 2008-2009, Highland granted \$749,000 to 18% of the student body. The grants ranged from 10% to 90% of tuition with an average grant of nearly \$7,700.

Families interested in information about financial aid should contact the Admission Office and consult our website for a copy of the Financial Aid Handbook. The handbook describes the application process which includes submitting information to Highland and School and Student Services (SSS) in Princeton, New Jersey. Families unsure about their ability to pay full tuition should apply for financial aid. All information and conversations pertaining to financial aid are held in the strictest of confidence. In addition, admission and financial aid are determined separately.

The application deadline for current families, January 9, 2009, is slightly before that of prospective families which is January 30, 2009. The Financial Aid Committee reviews each file carefully and awards grants on an annual basis. Families are notified of the financial aid decision before being asked to submit an enrollment contract.
